

OUTSTANDING CITIZEN –for a person who has voluntarily and unselfishly served Henry County (similar to Patrick Henry award). The service has continued over many years and has contributed immeasurably to the positive image of Henry Co. This person has been an inspiration to others. Through active civic involvement and fine example, this individual has been a continuous beacon for community betterment.

OUTSTANDING CHAMBER MEMBER-to recognize people who have sacrificed both personal and business time for the betterment of their community in their work with the Chamber. The nominees must have at least 3 years of service to the Chamber and not be a member of the Board or Staff.

OUTSTANDING FARMER- THE RECIPIENT WHO OWNS, OPERATES OR IS ACTIVE IN THE MANAGEMENT OF A Henry County farm with main income generated from farming. The family should reside on the farm and follow sound farming conservation practices and recommendations.

OUTSTANDING BUSINESS PERSON-to a person who owns, operates or is active in the management of a Henry County business and whose business and personal conduct is a credit to themselves, their company, their employees and their community. The candidate can come from any facet of business activity, must have been in business a minimum of three years and must currently be active in community and chamber affairs.

OUTSTANDING EDUCATOR- In recognition of the importance of education in our community and the desire to publicly recognize educator employed in Henry County who have contributed in an outstanding manner to the education of Henry County students, the nominee must be a teacher, administrator, or staff person employed in either Henry or Eminence school systems. By this award, the Chamber desires to recognize the importance of quality education in our community and recognize in particular those individuals whose actions have enhanced education in either the primary, secondary, vocational or adult education area.

OUTSTANDING EMERGENCY SERVICES PERSONNEL All emergency personnel, both volunteer and paid, are eligible for the award. This includes EMT, ambulance service, firefighters, police officers, rescue squad personnel, disaster and emergency services, dispatchers, and should be someone who has not only performed well in his or her role in emergency services in Henry County, but someone who has made an example of him/herself due to his/her role in emergency services provided to the community.

BUSINESS BEAUTIFICATION- given to a business in Henry County that has completed renovation or redesign of an existing property to enhance the overall look and/or appeal of the building. The recipient can be a new or existing business, and the work must have been done in the past 3 years. Before and after photos can be included but will not be required to nominate.
